

Guidelines for Submission of “SAHRS Best Academician Award” Nominations

Name of the Award:

The name of the award shall be **“SAHRS Best Academician Award”**

Objectives of the Award:

The Best Academician Award will be presented annually to deserving and exemplary faculty members in recognition of his/her extraordinary contributions rendered while teaching and in support of elevating student level. Although scholarly distinction is the primary qualification, emphasis is placed on the evidence of quality teaching including his /her contribution towards research and service to the institute and academic community.

Validity:

A nomination is valid for one year only. In case candidate is not selected during the year, there is no provision for nomination to be carried forward for the next year, however re-nomination is permitted.

Criteria:

1. The applicant must have at least 5 years of teaching/research/extension experience as regular faculty member in a HEI.
2. A faculty member may receive the SAHRS Best Academician Award only once.
3. The applicant should be a member of SAHRS.
4. The form should be duly forwarded by the concerning Head of the Department/Director of the Institute.
5. Claims should be as evidenced by teaching records, published research papers, patents or any other publications demonstrating outstanding contribution.

Selection Procedure:

All the valid nominations, based on the subject area of the teaching/research, will be considered by the respective sectional committees of the society.

The minimum cut-off markers will be 60%. If the candidate is not achieved 60% mark, then his/her application will be automatically rejected. If single application is received and has score of 60% or more then it will be considered.

THE AWARDEE WILL BE HONOURED WITH A CERTIFICATE ON THE OCCASION OF THE CONFERENCE OF THE YEAR.
