

Guidelines for Submission of Young Scientist Award Nominations

Name of the Award:

The name of the award shall be **“SAHRS Young Scientist Award”**

Objectives of the Award:

To recognize the talented young scientists who have shown extraordinary originality and dedication in their research programs. They should have exceptional creativity based on a track record of significant contribution to research and potential to facilitate the use of their expertise to further high-quality research in science and technology.

Validity:

A nomination is valid for one year only. In case candidate is not selected during the year, there is no provision for nomination to be carried forward for the next year, however re-nomination is permitted.

Criteria:

1. The candidate shall be a LIFE MEMBER of the society.
2. Age of applicant should not be more than 35 years as on the day of the conference.
3. The form should be duly forwarded by the concerning Head of the Department/Director of the Institute.
4. Applicant should be an active Scientist/Faculty/Post-Doctoral Fellow and should have outstanding contributions to research, education and extension in any field of basic and applied sciences, while working in India.
5. Claims should be as evidenced by published research papers, patents or any other publications demonstrating outstanding research work, inventions or discoveries, original contributions in upliftment of education and extension activities in the field of basic and applied sciences.
6. Achievements of applicants which have received any other Institutional/National/International award, shall not be considered for this Award.

Selection Procedure:

All the valid nominations, based on the subject area of the work, will be considered by the respective sectional committees of the society.

The minimum cut-off markers will be 60%. If the candidate is not achieved 60% mark, then his/her application will be automatically rejected. If single application is received and has score of 60% or more then it will be considered.

THE AWARDEE WILL BE HONOURED WITH A CERTIFICATE ON THE OCCASION OF THE CONFERENCE OF THE YEAR.
